



Maritime Museum of San Diego Administrative Policies for Commercial Media Production

All persons interested in filming on board the ships of the Maritime Museum of San Diego must submit a written proposal. Proposal should include the following:

- Business name, person to contact and contact information for the production company
- Name of the ultimate parent company of the production company (if any)
- Proposed shot list and production schedule
- Intended use of the footage shot at the maritime museum
- One paragraph description of the project footage is to be used for including its ultimate distribution (DVD/Video, cable/broadcast television, theatrical motion picture, Advertising, Catalog, etc.)

Submit information 45 days prior to proposed shooting dates to:

Upon approval production company must submit the following 30 days prior to shoot date along with 50% deposit*:

- Proof of current, valid liability insurance in the amount of \$1 million with the Maritime Museum of San Diego and the Port of San Diego as named insured
- Proof of current, valid workers compensation insurance covering the production company's employees while they are on museum property.
- Completed Maritime Museum of San Diego Film Production Location Agreement

*NOTE ON DEPOSITS: In order to receive a deposit refund the production company must notify the maritime museum of a cancellation at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled shooting dates. The maritime museum will refund the deposit less a 10% handling fee within 30 days of the notice of cancellation. If the production company fails to notify the museum of a cancellation within the time period specified then they may forfeit their deposit.
